



RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP Ref. DIR/04859_14

A call for tenders is now open for the attribution of <u>four</u> Research Scholarships within the scope of the research projects: Citizenship, solidarity and social inclusion; Business Law; Global Challenges of European Integration; See the Future - Sea, Environment and Natural Resources within the scope of CEID-CRCFL's pluriannual financing contract-programme (UIDB/04859/2020), financed by national funds from the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P. (FCT, IP).

Scientific area: Law

Admission requirements:

Applicants for the Research Scholarships must, at the time of application, be registered or present proof of conditional registration in a Ph.D. degree in Law area.

Candidates must have a master's degree in law, a bachelor's degree in law with a final classification of 13 or higher, and a good language skills. Preference will be given to candidates who have research experience in the field of law, specifically in: Citizenship, solidarity, and social inclusion; Business Law; Global Challenges of European Integration; See the Future - Sea, Environment and Natural Resources.

Work Plan:

This project aims to promote scientific research in the fields of: Citizenship, solidarity and social inclusion; Business Law; Global Challenges of European Integration; Sea, Environment and Natural Resources.

Workplace:

The work will be carried out at CEID-CRCFL – Centro de Estudos e Investigação em Direito – Católica Research Centre for the Future of Law, Universidade Católica Portuguesa – Faculty of Law, Porto/Lisbon under the scientific guidance of Professor Sofia Pais.







Duration of the scholarship:

The scholarships, scheduled to start on 1st February 2024, will have the duration of 11 months on an exclusive basis.

Monthly maintenance allowance:

The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €1 199,64, according to the research scholarship values awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the Country (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2023/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM 2023.pdf), and will be paid by bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection methods to be used will be as follows:

- a) Curricular evaluation;
- b) Interview.

The curricular evaluation (CE) will result from the weighted average of the partial classifications resulting from the applicable selection method, on a scale from 0 (zero) to 20 (twenty), determined through the following formula:

CE= 0.35P1+0.35P2+0.15P3+0.15P4, where P1= Academic education, P2= Curriculum Vitae analysis, considering professional and research experience and familiarity with the themes developed in the project, P3= Languages, P4= Motivation Letter.

Candidates who are classified with 15 (fifteen) or higher will be invited via email (e-mail) for a professional interview.

The final classification (FC) of the candidates will result from the weighted average of the partial classifications resulting from the applicable selection method, on a scale from 0 (zero) to 20 (twenty), determined using the following formula:

FC= 0.60CE + 0,40I, where CE=Curricular evaluation, I=Interview.

Important notice for candidates with degrees issued by foreign higher education institutions:

- Candidates with diplomas issued by foreign higher education institutions may apply and will be evaluated with the same criteria as candidates with diplomas issued by Portuguese institutions, provided that they present, in their application, proof of recognition of academic degrees and conversion of final classification for the Portuguese classification scale under the terms of the applicable legislation.







- Candidates with foreign degrees that do not show proof of conversion of their final classification to the Portuguese classification scale will be assessed with the minimum classification in P1 academic education (10 points).
- In any case, scholarship contracts with candidates with diplomas issued by foreign institutions will only be concluded upon presentation of proof of recognition of academic degrees and conversion of the final classification, as indicated above.

Composition of the Selection Jury: Professor Sofia Pais (President); Professor Conceição Cunha (Effective member); Professor Elsa Vaz de Sequeira (Effective member), and Professor Manuel António Fontaine Campos (Substitute member).

Form of advertising/notification of results:

The jury deliberates in accordance with the selection criteria adopted and disclosed. The jury meetings minutes will contain a summary of the meeting content. After completing the application of the selection criteria, the jury proceeds with the elaboration of the ordered list, with the ranking of the approved candidates. The ranking list of eligible candidates will be published on the premises of the Universidade Católica Portuguesa, in Porto and each candidate being notified of their position on the list ranking of candidates via email. Ineligible applicants will be notified by email, with details of the missing eligibility elements.

Complaint and appeal procedures:

Candidates have a period of ten working days, after the disclosure referred in the previous number, to give their opinion at a prior hearing.

Deadline for acceptance of the scholarship:

Within ten working days following notification of the grant award, the selected candidate must confirm in writing their availability to start the scholarship on the proposed date. Failing to do so or not having availability, the candidate placed in the next position will be called.

Application deadline and form of submission:

Applications will be accepted between 22/12/2023 and 09/01/2024; 17:00.

Applications must be sent by email to <u>inicolescu@ucp.pt</u>, <u>identifying in the subject of the email</u> "Application to the competition with the reference DIR/04859 14".

The following documents should be submitted:

- 1) Cover letter, identifying the title and reference of the project, and describing the motivation and professional objectives of the candidate;
- 2) Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- 3) Copy of the certificate(s) of qualifications conferring academic degree in the terms requested in the notice, containing the final classifications;







- 4) If the required academic degree has been awarded by a foreign higher education institution, the candidate must submit the Certificate of Recognition of the academic degrees and a record of the conversion of the respective final classification to the Portuguese classification scale or proof of the request for recognition under Portuguese legislation. ¹
- 5) Proof of enrolment in a Higher Education Institution in study cycles leading to an academic degree in Ph.D. Law area.

Only applications received during the opening period of the above-mentioned call shall be considered.

Candidates who incorrectly formalize their application or who do not prove the requirements of this call are excluded. False statements made by applicants will be punished under the law.

Mandatory documentation:

The following documents must be sent, at the time of the eventual granting of the scholarship, for the purposes of its contractualization:

- a) Copy of the ID/Passport document and Tax identification document(s);²;
- b) Copy of all academic degree certificates;
- c) Document of the registration of recognition of foreign academic degrees;
- d) Document proving enrolment in the course conferring the academic degree identified in this Notice;
- e) Statement by the supervisor(s) assuming responsibility for supervising the work plan, pursuant to article 5-A of the Research Fellowship Statute;
- f) Updated document proving compliance with the exclusive dedication regime

¹If the required academic degree has been awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it must comply with the provisions of Portuguese legislation on the recognition of foreign degrees, regulated by DL nº 66/2018, of 16 August. In case the candidate is selected, the signing of the contract is conditioned to the presentation of the formal document.
