SYLLABUS

Through the reading and analysis of international case-law, the students will study different issues on international law, such as:

self-determination of the people, fight against terrorism – human rights and international humanitarian law;

refugees and migrants;

attribution of a conduct to the state;

the relation between the ECHR and ECJ, etc.

In exceptional cases, when domestic decisions have used international law, judgments of domestic courts (constitutional) will be studied.
